Description:	AYS Academy is an alternative school for students who have been suspended for one to two full semesters from the Kansas City, Kansas, school district.
Duties:	Volunteers will tutor junior high and high school students in a variety of subjects, especially math and reading.
What is meaningful about this position?	AYS Academy provides many of these students their only remaining opportunity to improve their grades and keep up with their peers in school. By improving their academic skills, tutors will help students be more confident, driven, and successful when they return to their home school.
Dates Needed:	We have an ongoing need for tutors during the school year. Tutors choose a day and time to come on a weekly basis during the school day.
