Agency:	Associated Youth Services (AYS)
Job Title:	Home Ties Math Skills Tutor
Description:	Home Ties is a Youth Residential Center that houses up to 10 adolescent boys. During their time at Home Ties, the boys are required to attend school or hold down a job. The teens are in need of instructors to teach them basic math skills before they are released into independent living situations.
Duties:	Volunteers will tutor junior high and high school students in math.
What is meaningful about this position?	By improving their academic skills, tutors will help students be more confident, driven, and successful throughout the rest of their daily lives.
Dates Needed:	We have an ongoing need for tutors. Tutors choose a day and time to come on a weekly basis.

Desired Qualifications:	No tutoring experience is required. Tutors must be proficient in high school math and reading and possess at least a high school diploma or GED.
Training provided:	Volunteers will receive an orientation on-site. AYS staff will provide guidance & support to volunteers and be available at all times.
Numbers of Volunteers Needed:	1 to 2 tutors can volunteer at one time
Length of commitment:	At least 3 months, 1-2 hours per week. Commitment is negotiable.
