Life Skills Instructor Volunteer Task Description

Agency:	Associated Youth Services (AYS)
Job Title:	Life Skills Instructor
Description:	AYS serves underprivileged youth in crisis through five programs. You can help inspire our young people to succeed by serving as a role model for our clients and preparing a Life Skills Presentation for the clientele of one of our programs.
What is meaningful about this position?	Our clients often lack the support systems that many of us take for granted. As a result, they may not have been taught basic and necessary life skills. Instructors contribute to the education of our youth by providing useful, practical information.
Duties:	Life Skills Instructors will prepare and deliver a presentation about a useful life skill. The skill usually derives from the volunteer's profession or particular life experiences. A volunteer may teach our youth about personal financial management or about the basics of car maintenance. Topics can be basic, but should be useful to our clients. Volunteers are encouraged to make their presentations interactive and entertaining.
Dates Needed:	Exact dates and times are flexible and dependant on which program an Instructor has an interest in.

Age Requirement:	21+
Desired Qualifications:	Volunteers should be an expert in their chosen subject area. Experience teaching or speaking in front of groups is preferred, but not required.
Training provided:	Instructors will receive an orientation from AYS staff as well as guidance as they are preparing their presentation(s).
Numbers of Volunteers Needed:	1-3 individuals may volunteer at one time.
Length of commitment:	This is a one time commitment of 1-2 hours, with potential for continuation.
