# Video Production Mentor Volunteer Task Description

<b>Agency:</b>	Associated Youth Services (AYS)
<b>Job Title:</b>	Stack the Decks Youth Video Production Mentor
<b>Description:</b>	Stack the Decks is our annual fundraiser and casino night. Stack the Decks 2011 is scheduled for April 8 at the Ritz Charles. Help us stack the decks in favor of underprivileged youth in crisis!
<b>What is meaningful about this position?</b>	This position is responsible for giving AYS youth a chance to learn new skills, while also giving them the chance to be responsible for the quality of a project from start to finish. Ostensibly giving them a valuable sense of ownership and pride in their accomplishment.
<b>Duties:</b>	This position takes on the responsibility of mentoring and providing technical guidance to AYS youth while they go through the process of putting together a semi-professional video depicting AYS' programs and their positive effects. This video will then be presented at Stack the Decks Casino Night 2011 as a way to introduce new supporters to AYS' mission.
<b>Dates Needed:</b>	Schedule is flexible, but requires a sufficient amount of time required to successfully guide AYS youth during production (i.e. several times monthly until the conclusion of the project)
<b>Length of Commitment:</b>	This is a reoccurring commitment. Length depends on frequency of meeting.
<b>Location of Volunteer Work:</b>	Various locations depending on the collaborative decisions of the mentor and AYS youth.
<b>Age Requirement:</b>	Age 18+
<b>Desired Qualifications:</b>	The mentor should have experience in video production, including: editing, filming, and directing. A mentor should also have experience and an interest in helping youth, preferably youth that have some behavior issues. It is important that the youth take ownership of the project, and that the mentor should be able to guide them without taking over the project (Mr. Miyagi, please!).
